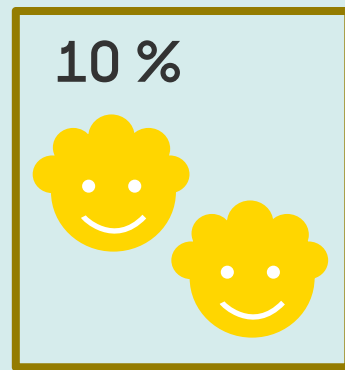
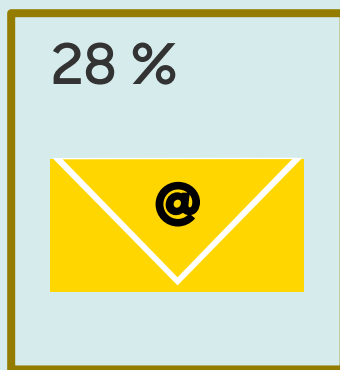
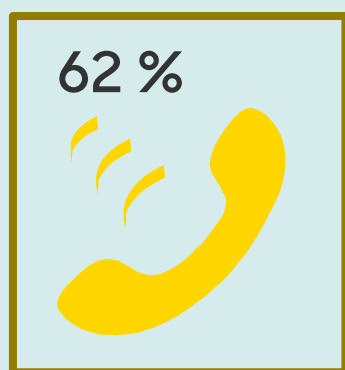


Did you know ?

dealing with an average of 253 enquiries a MONTH

that's **430,000** enquiries every YEAR across England



73% families, 27% professionals use FIS

The nature of enquiries are:

35% Childcare options

7% Special Educational Needs

20% Free childcare entitlement for some 2 year-olds

7% School Admissions

8% Leisure, sports, arts

9% Childminder registration

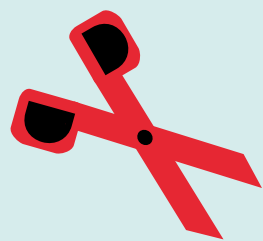
10% Parent Support

Under the Childcare Act 2006, local authorities in England are obliged to run a service providing

information, advice and assistance

about *childcare and other activities* of benefit to parents, children and young people up to the age of 20.
