


What's that?




What do parents tell us?




6 in 10 women who have had an abortion claim that childcare costs influenced their decision



Almost two thirds of families are paying the same or more for childcare as their rent or mortgage



18% of parents said that their childcare costs had increased by 11% or more in the last 10 months



52% of parents have had to cut back on non-essentials to pay for childcare



One in four parents say they have had to skip meals, heating or fuel to pay for childcare



38% of parents said that childcare costs have prevented them from having more children



We asked parents what was causing them the most stress & anxiety right now. Just over half said the cost of living crisis. A third said childcare COSTS.
