Definitions

Monitoring

Involves observing and checking the progress or quality of (something) over a period of time

Evaluation

Goes a step further and tells us how a policy or intervention was implemented, what effects it had, for whom, how and why. It weighs up the pros and cons of the intervention and tells us how to improve it

All of this monitoring and evaluation produces evidence:

This can take the form of facts, figures, ideas, analysis and research





Why is Monitoring & Evaluation important?



- Identify groups and communities that may need more support
- Demonstrate the positive changes your Parent Champions are making to local communities
- Find out if the programme is working well
- Evidence for procurement or funding bids to support your scheme





Monitoring Impact



In order to monitor the success of your scheme, you might collect data on:

- Parent Champions' engagements with parents
- Subsequent take up of local services, for example free childcare places for young children
- The impact that volunteering has had on your Parent Champion
